Summary

Tennessee's October seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.4% from the previous month.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased from 3.3% to 3.4% while the national rate declined from 3.8% to 3.6%.

Total nonfarm employment decreased 5,100 jobs from September to October. The largest decreases occurred in manufacturing, professional/business services, and other services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 38,900 jobs. The largest increases occurred in leisure/hospitality, professional/business services, and trade/transportation/utilities.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2017 to 2019




Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee Seasonally Adjusted - January 2012 to October 2019
