Summary

Tennessee's June seasonally adjusted unemployment rate slightly decreased to 4.9% from the May revised rate of 5.0%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from 9.3% to 4.9% while the national rate decreased from 11.1% to 5.9%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 22,100 jobs from May to June. The largest increases occurred in local government, accommodation/food services, and administrative/support/waste services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 153,400 jobs. The largest increases occurred in professional/business services, leisure/hospitality, and trade/transportation/utilities.


