## Summary

Tennessee's June seasonally adjusted unemployment rate slightly decreased to $4.9 \%$ from the May revised rate of 5.0\%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate decreased from $9.3 \%$ to $4.9 \%$ while the national rate decreased from $11.1 \%$ to $5.9 \%$.

Total nonfarm employment increased 22,100 jobs from May to June. The largest increases occurred in local government, accommodation/food services, and administrative/support/waste services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 153,400 jobs. The largest increases occurred in professional/business services, leisure/hospitality, and trade/transportation/utilities.
