Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 119,400 jobs. The largest increases were in Leisure and Hospitality, Education & Health Services, and Trade, Transportation and Utilities.

Over the month, total nonfarm employment increased 6,400. The largest increases were in Accommodation & Food Services, Wholesale Trade, and Transportation, Warehousing & Utilities.





Seasonally Adjusted - 2020 to 2022




# **Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee**Seasonally Adjusted - January 2015 to November 2022
