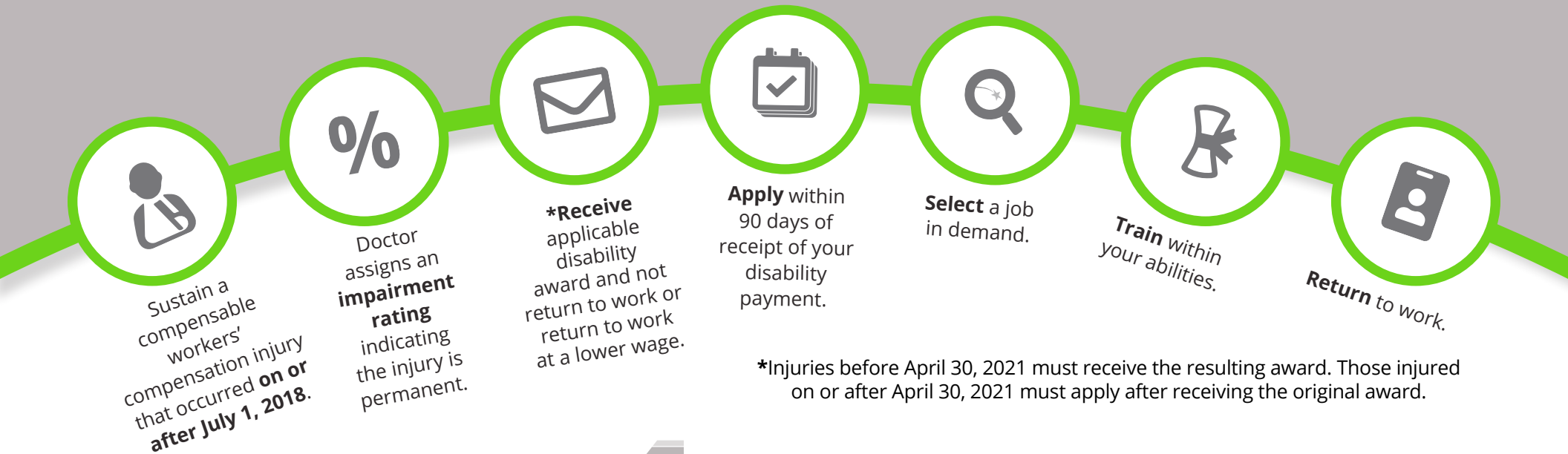

A permanent disability from a workplace accident can lead to new opportunities. Connect with public institutions and resources to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to get back to work.

Go Back to School to Get the Job You Always Wanted

Receive up to \$5,000 for tuition and expenses per fiscal year to attend a College of Applied Technology, community college, or state university in Tennessee. Recipients can receive up to \$20,000 in their lifetime.
