This response reflects flawed proficiency in persuasive writing skills. The writer does not agree that the rise in violent crime in the United States is caused by movies and video games but instead attributes this rise in crime to the environment. The difference between urban and rural areas is presented to support this position (urban places because they know it will be hard to find them; in smaller rural areas everybody knows everybody). There is very little development and no apparent organization. In addition to serious word usage errors, the writer demonstrates no understanding of sentence structure.
