The division will hold a public hearing to seek comment concerning an application for a state water quality permit. The hearing is in regard to the proposal by H & E Enterprises to install 276' of culvert on Little Creek.

Proposed alterations would occur on Little Creek located in the City of Cookeville within Putnam County. Proposed alterations include the encapsulation of 276 feet of stream to facilitate residential development, mitigation is proposed in the form of payment into the Tennessee Stream Mitigation Program.

The hearing officer will limit all testimony to relevant water quality issues and may limit testimony in the interest of time. However, all persons desiring to speak will be given an opportunity to do so. Written testimony will be accepted for 10 days following the hearing and will be considered part of the official record. The public is also invited to submit comments in writing to the division at the address printed below. The comments must be received by October 2, 2009. After considering all public comments, the division will publish a final permit decision and a notice of the division's determinations.
