AN ACT To amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-111, relative to antique motor vehicles.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-4-111(b)(4), is amended by deleting the subdivision (4)(A) in its entirety and substituting instead the following:

(4)(A) The owner or lessee of an antique motor vehicle may display the license plates from an era when the manufacture of such vehicle occurred instead of the current license plates; provided, that current license plates are maintained in the vehicle by the owner or lessee and produced for inspection upon the request of any law enforcement officer.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
