AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, relative to smoking in buildings owned or operated by the state.


BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-4-121, is amended by deleting such section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following language:

Section 4-4-121. Smoking shall be prohibited in all buildings that are owned or operated by the State of Tennessee, except for those sleeping rooms in state park inns and cabins that are designated as smoking rooms or cabins. It is the intent of the general assembly that all buildings that are owned or operated by the state other than sleeping rooms in state park inns and cabins designated for smoking shall be completely smoke-free.

SECTION 2. For the purposes of implementation in correctional facilities owned or operated by the Department of Correction, this act shall take effect July 1, 2007, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
