Emergency Waiver Concerning Gasoline
September 20, 2016

The commissioner of the Tennessee Department of Agriculture is authorized by Tenn. Code Ann. § 47-18-1304(c) to waive ASTM standards for kerosene and motor fuels, or to establish alternative standards, for a specified period of time when such action is deemed necessary to protect or promote public health, safety, general welfare, and the interests of citizens of Tennessee

Due to the disruption of fuel supplies being experienced by Colonial pipeline at this time and based upon the authority granted by Tenn. Code Ann. § 47-18-1304(c), Tennessee Commissioner of Agriculture Jai Templeton hereby issues a waiver of Tennessee fuel quality standards by permitting the use of gasoline meeting ASTM D 4814 Volatility Class D-4 specifications. This waiver shall be in effect through midnight September 30, 2016.

As of October 1, 2016, gasoline with volatility class C-3 and D-4 are appropriate for use in Tennessee.
