

# I-CAR Non-Structural Technician ProLevel 1

## Description

The exam for Non-Structural ProLevel 1 includes content on hazardous materials, personal safety, and refinish safety; trim and hardware; non-structural supplement; bolted-on part replacement; movable glass; corrosion protection; plastic and composite repair; lighting, starting, and charging systems; automotive foams; advanced high-strength steel overview; and vehicle technology and trends. The I-CAR Non-Structural Technician ProLevel 1 certification is obtainable through an end of program exam for students who complete study through the I-CAR curriculum, Professional Development Program-Education Edition (PDP-EE). I-CAR curriculum is commonly used in industry to train auto body and related repairers. After completing the I-CAR ProLevel 1 curriculum and passing the aligned I-CAR end of program exam, students receive the Platinum designation. ## Registration Procedures

Students establish individual accounts and progress through the curriculum beginning with the Intro to Collision Repair series and followed by Non-Structural and/or Painting and Refinishing ProLevel 1 content. As students complete the program, another form must be completed and turned in to I-CAR to purchase the end of program exams.
