


Paleoindian Archaeology at the Carson-Conn-Short Site

John Broster and I have conducted archaeological investigations at the Paleoindian age Carson-Conn-Site, 40BN190 in Benton County since 1992. During this time frame we piece plotted a large number of the artifacts we discovered- creating a point provenience map. This map provides some insights to the various activities taking place at this locale. This presentation is a preliminary look at data that was presented at the Southeastern Archaeological Conference in Nashville last month.
