This year will also include the replication of ground stone tools and the use of the bow and pump drills. I will have a large sandstone metate to replicate numerous ground stone implements such as a celt, agricultural hoe, wood working adze, a gorget, and more. Stanley Blanchard crafted both a bow and pump drill, which we will utilize to perforate stone – the same method Native Americans employed for thousands of years.
