PUBLIC NOTICE

The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control (TDAPC) has received requests for construction and/or modification of air contaminant sources as noted below. The proposed construction and/or modification is subject to part 1200-03-09-.01(1)(h) of the Tennessee Air Pollution Control Regulations, which requires a public notification and 30-day public comment period. Interested parties may express their comments and concerns in writing to Mrs. Michelle W. Owenby, Director, Division of Air Pollution Control, William R. Snodgrass Tennessee Tower, 312 Rosa L. Parks Avenue, 15th Floor, Nashville, Tennessee 37243 within thirty (30) days of the date of this notice. Any individuals with disabilities who wish to participate in these proceedings or to review these filings should contact the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to discuss any auxiliary aids or services needed to facilitate such participation. Such initial contact may be in person, by writing, telephone, or other means, and should be made no less than ten (10) days prior to the hearing, or the date such party intends to review such filings, to allow time to provide such aid or service. The applicant is Clay County Emergency Operations with a mailing address of 145 Cordell Hull Drive, Celina, TN 38551. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 14-0035-01/72008) for the construction of one natural gas powered engine located at 143 Cordell Hull Drive, Celina, TN 38551. This proposed operation consists of one emergency generator powered by a natural gas engine and associated equipment used for emergency power. Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction at this source. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this operation. Mr. Doug Wright is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Crossville, Inc. dba Administration with a mailing address of PO Box 1168, Crossville, TN 38557. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 18-0208-01/71937) for the construction of an Emergency Generator located at the 349 Sweeney Drive, Crossville, TN 38555. This proposed operation would consist of one (1) generator with a natural gas-fired engine (56 kW) and associated equipment used to produce power. Due to the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. J. Horton is the assigned Division person.

Source 01: This proposed operation would consist of gravel, sand, and cement stockpiles, two (2) storage silos, weigh-batch mixer, and associated equipment used to produce concrete. Fabric filter bag-houses would be used as pollution control. There would be physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted at this facility. The applicant is Design Team Sign Company LLC with a mailing and site address of 350 Pinhook Drive, Savannah, TN 38372. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number: 36-0132-01/971830) for a Coating Process (for wood, metal, and plastic products). Because of the amount and type of emissions, the use of pollution control equipment is not proposed. There would be no physical construction. Regulated air contaminants would be emitted by this source. Mr. Abbas Yavari is the assigned Division person.

The applicant is Occidental Chemical Corporation with a mailing address of P.O. Box 524, New Johnsonville, TN 37134. They seek to obtain an air contaminant permit (Division identification number 43-0084-12/ 71913) for installation of one Hydrogen fueled steam generating Boiler (76.4 mmBTU/hour heat input rate), at 1900 DuPont Road, New Johnsonville, TN 37134. Because of the nature and type of operation, no control device is required but the company has proposed to install Low NOx burner technology for the boiler. There would be physical construction and regulated air contaminants are emitted by this source. Mr. Manir Ahmed is the assigned Division person.
