

PUBLIC NOTICE
Revised Corrective Action Plan Submitted By
The Egyptian Lacquer Manufacturing Company

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) is seeking public comment on the Revised Corrective Action Plan (CAP) submitted by the Egyptian Lacquer Manufacturing Company (ELMCO). This CAP was submitted on June 23, 2008, for TDEC's review and approval pursuant to the Consent Agreement and Order previously entered into by TDEC and ELMCO. The revised CAP describes ELMCO's proposal for addressing the residual organic solvent contamination in soil and groundwater that resulted from the accidental release of solvents from leaking underground pipelines at ELMCO's paint manufacturing facility at 113 Fort Granger Drive in Franklin, Tennessee.

A copy of the revised CAP may be viewed at the Williamson County Public Library located at 1314 Columbia Avenue, Franklin, Tennessee and at TDEC's Division of Solid Waste Management (DSWM) offices on the 5th Floor of the L&C Tower, 401 Church Street, Nashville, Tennessee. The Library is open Monday through Thursday, 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Sunday 1:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., exclusive of holidays. TDEC will conduct a Public Meeting on August 7, 2008, from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. CDT at the Franklin City Hall located at 109 Third Avenue South in Franklin, Tennessee. At this Public Meeting representatives of ELMCO will describe the proposed CAP. Following this presentation interested persons will be given the opportunity to provide oral or written comments concerning the proposed CAP.
