TBI Successes


- **TOP 10 FUGITIVES**
 - Captured 23 Top 10 Fugitives this past fiscal year
- **DRUG INVESTIGATION DIVISION**
 - Arrested 147 offenders and obtained 327 federal and felony convictions
- **CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION DIVISION**
 - Opened 954 cases, closed 840 cases, made 252 arrests, and obtained 240 convictions
- **FORENSIC SERVICES DIVISION**
 - Received accreditation for the new ASCLD/LAB, the highest level available worldwide
- **INFORMATION SYSTEMS DIVISION**
 - Conducted background checks on individuals through 410,898 firearms transactions
 - Processed 613,731 Fingerprint submissions
- **TRAINING DIVISION**
 - Provided caseworkers basic law enforcement skills
 - Provided specialized training for 8,500 Tennessee law enforcement personnel



TBI Challenges

- **Maintaining the Meth & Pharmaceutical Task Force**
 - Was fully funded by federal grant dollars, which have recently been significantly reduced and narrowed in scope. Local Law enforcement will have to take over cleanup in each county July 1st.
- **Gangs**
 - There has been an increase in gang-related homicides in West Tennessee.
- **Human Trafficking**
 - Too often, victims may not see themselves as victims. We need solutions to meet the needs – physical, mental, and emotional – of those who find a way out, and ways to put a stop to sex trafficking.

Revenue Sources






Proposed Reduction Plan

Priority	Category	Reduction Description	State Savings
1.	Program & Operations	Reduce operational expenses, such as travel, supplies, equipment, and training.	\$1,025,100
2.	Program & Operations	Reduce general fund state dollars by recognizing additional current services revenue in Record Checks.	\$1,100,000
