Copies of the Contract Documents must be obtained at the office of the Engineer, **McGill Associates, P.A., located at 2240 Sutherland Ave., Suite 2, Knoxville, Tennessee, 37919, upon payment of \$150.00 for each set. There will be no refund to any party for Contract Documents so obtained.** All Bids submitted must be prepared with documents obtained from the office of the Engineer.

A certified check or cashier's check payable to the Owner or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by a corporate surety licensed under the laws of Tennessee to execute such Bonds in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total of the Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

Attention is called to the fact that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.

The Bid deposit shall be retained by the Owner if the successful Bidder fails to execute the Contract or fails to provide the required Bonds, as stated above, within ten (10) days after award of the Contract.

The successful Bidder shall be required to furnish separate one hundred percent (100%) Performance and Payment Bonds. The Performance Bond shall be in full

force and effect for one (1) year after the date of final acceptance of the project by the Owner.

Each Bidder must be appropriately licensed as a Contractor in the State of Tennessee as provided in T.C.A. 62-6-101. The Bidder's name, license number, expiration date, and that part of the contracting classification applying to the Bid shall appear on the sealed envelope containing the Bid; otherwise, the Bid shall not be opened.

Each Bidder shall make positive efforts to use small and minority owned business enterprises on this project.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bid proposals and to waive all informalities. A conditional or qualified BID will not be accepted. Award will be made to the lowest responsible, responsive BIDDERS.
