

Tennessee State Parks Resale Soft Drinks and Fountain Drinks

- The contractor will provide bottled, canned and fountain beverage products to the State for use in restaurant, catering, and resale operations at the specified Tennessee State Parks.
- Orders shall be delivered within 48 hours of placing the order. Deliveries must be made during the business hours of 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- The contractor must invoice according to the item description, unit of measure and price on the contract. The contractor accepts net 45 payment terms. The delivery location must be listed on the invoice.
- The State shall retain all monies from retail, catering and fountain sales.

Fountain Equipment

- Dispensing equipment must be supplied, installed and maintained by the vendor at no cost to the State.
- Installation must be coordinated with the respective hospitality manager. Hospitality manager contact information will be provided by the State at the time of award.
- Contractor must respond to all maintenance and repair requests via telephone or email within 24 hours.
- Repairs and replacements must be complete within 48 hours of the request unless otherwise authorized by park hospitality manager.
- All equipment must be new or refurbished like new and state of art and remain in that condition throughout the life of the contract. All equipment shall at all times remain the sole property of the Contractor.
- All dispensers must be equipped with locks and/or shut off devices at no cost to the State.
- All dispensers must be equipped with separate water supply shut off.
- CO2 tanks must be 20-lb capacity with capped faucet for sanitary purposes. All empty tanks must be removed at time of delivery of full tanks.
