Updates on the Tennessee Health Care Innovation Initiative

- *February episode of care reports*
 - The February episode of care reports from BCBST, UnitedHealthcare and Amerigroup have not yet been released.
 - The state and the MCOs are engaged in additional reviews of wave 1 episode of care reports, and the MCOs will hold the reports until the review is completed.

- *Website update*
 - We continue to add new information to the Tennessee Health Care Innovation Initiative website.
 - In spring of 2015, Tennessee will redesign all state government websites. We are aware that many of you include links to our website in your member or provider communications. We would ask that going forward you verify all links before adding them to any communication to ensure the information being provided is accurate and helpful.

- *Primary Care Transformation RFP*
 - Last Thursday, the state released a Request for Proposal for consultation services regarding the statewide implementation of our Primary Care Transformation strategy. Contracted services will include designing, implementing, and supporting the state's multi-payer Patient-Centered Medical Homes (PCMH) and Medicaid Health Homes for TennCare members with severe and persistent mental illness.
 - The contract period is scheduled to begin May 15, 2015, and this work will be fully funded by Tennessee's \$65M SIM Round 2 Model Test grant.
 - TAGs will be run for Multi-payer PCMH and Health Homes between June and September 2015.

Upcoming meetings

- *Upcoming wave 3 Technical Advisory Meetings*
 - On Wednesday, February 18th, the state sent out notifications to all wave 3 TAG nominees regarding their acceptance or rejection.
 - For wave 3, the state received over 100 TAG nominees to participate in three TAG groups. Because of this, the state increased the size of each TAG to 18 clinicians.
 - We will circulate a final list of all wave 3 TAG members next week.
