

Wave 2 Episodes of Care

In 2015, the initiative launched five episodes of care:

- Acute COPD Exacerbation
- Screening and surveillance colonoscopy
- Outpatient and non-acute inpatient cholecystectomy
- Acute percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI)
- Non-acute percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI)

Where we are in the process: Performance Period (Calendar Year 2016)

Providers are receiving quarterly reports for Wave 2 episodes. The first performance period was January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016. Shared savings rewards and shared risk penalties will be assessed after release of the final report in August 2017.
