

Primary Care Director, Mid-Cumberland Region

Description: The Mid-Cumberland Region of the Tennessee Department of Health is seeking a Primary Care Director. The Mid-Cumberland Region is the most populous of the state's 13 public health jurisdictions, encompassing twelve counties with a total population of 1.2 million people. The region provides primary care in 16 local health department sites, including a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC).

Responsibilities:

- Provide clinical mentoring to local health department providers (physicians and advanced practice nurses) including initial and ongoing professional practice evaluations, chart reviews and individualized clinical guidance.
- Facilitate onboarding, training and continuing education of local health department providers.
- Utilize quality improvement methods to ensure and maintain efficient and effective clinic processes, including patient flow.
- Analyze monthly productivity reports.
- Monitor lab usage for appropriateness and review other clinical reports as needed.
- Oversee reallocation of clinical resources within the region based on need.
- Serve as the Chief Medical Officer for the Stewart County FQHC
 - Provide primary clinical care to health department patients one day per week
 - Participate in monthly board meetings and team meetings

Requirements: Doctor of Medicine or Doctor of Osteopathy with board certification/board eligibility in internal medicine or family medicine. Strong clinical skills with clinical mentoring experience. Medical licensure in state of Tennessee. Experience in public health or FQHCs preferred.
