## Programs

### ■ SNAC - Spay Neuter Assistance Clarksville

Low-cost spay and neuter program for qualifying pet owners to reduce the number of homeless animals and reduce euthanasia rates.



### ■ AWAS - Animal Welfare Assistance Services

Financial aid to qualifying families in need of assistance with companion animal care.

### ■ SRSP - Shelter & Rescue Support Program

Grants to qualified shelters/rescues for medical expenses of homeless animals.

*Montgomery, right, was hit by a car, and fractured his leg. Our SRSP program provided financial resources to transfer him from Montgomery County Animal Services to a Lab rescue that could oversee his care and placement.*



### ■ ATCP - Anti-Tethering and Chaining Program

Humane education through programs and outreach To improve the quality of life for chained pets by encouraging alternatives to permanent tethering.

### ■ BARK - Be Aware, Responsible and Kind

Provides: speakers on community animal welfare issues; dog bite prevention and pet care programs for groups, schools, or YMCA and county summer programs; and freelance writers for articles on community animal welfare issues.

## Services

### ■ Pet Adoptions

### ■ Foster Program

Pets awaiting adoption are placed with temporary foster families who provide food and love, while the Humane Society pays for vet care. Foster families are always needed.

### ■ Pet Food Bank & More

Donated dog and cat food, blankets, toys and cat litter make up a bank of pet supplies used for the care and feeding of pets belonging to low or limited income owners as well as the care of pets temporarily residing in foster homes.

### ■ Dog House Donations

Donated dog houses in good condition are given to qualifying pet owners to improve the lives of outside dogs in need.

### ■ Guardian Angel Program

Supporters donate monthly at five levels: Guardian, \$5; Bronze, \$10; Silver, \$20; Gold, \$25; and Platinum, \$50 or more. Regular donations allow us to commit funds to the care and rehabilitation of abused, injured and surrendered pets that enter our programs.
