## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 941**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 6 and Title 40, Chapter 39, relative to invasion of privacy.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-605, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

( ) In addition to the punishment provided for a person who commits the misdemeanor unlawful photographing in violation of privacy, the trial judge may order, after taking into account the facts and circumstances surrounding the offense, including the offense for which the person was originally charged and whether the conviction was the result of a plea bargain agreement, that the person be required to register as a sexual offender pursuant to title 40, chapter 39, part 2.


SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-39-202(20)(A) is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

( ) Unlawful photographing, under § 39-13-605, when convicted as a misdemeanor if the judge orders the person to register as a sexual offender pursuant to § 39-13-605;

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.


