
**SUBJECT: Proprietary Item Request and Justification
City of Pulaski
Camera Detection Equipment**

The City of Pulaski requests approval to use the Iteris Indicator Cameras as vehicle detection equipment on all signalization projects within the City of Pulaski as they are designed and bid. The following are justifications for this request.

- 1) Allowing the use of the requested vehicle detection equipment will facilitate synchronization with the City's current network of signal equipment. The City of Pulaski currently maintains fourteen (14) signalized intersections. Six (6) of these intersections currently have the Iteris Indicator Cameras for vehicle detection and the City is using this equipment as the standard for detection as opportunities arise.
- 2) The electric service crews and the signal maintenance contractor are trained in the trouble-shooting and maintenance of this brand of vehicle detection. The ability to specify this equipment within the city limits will allow for more efficient and less expensive repair and maintenance due to the city's familiarity with this product.


