



SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL Mini-Grant Program



Background:	The Tennessee Safe Routes to School Mini-Grant Program provides assistance to schools and communities to support safety education and encouragement for walking and biking to school.
Request Limit:	Maximum of \$5000 per school.
Eligible Recipients:	All elementary and middle schools, public and private, are eligible to apply for this program. Applicants must apply through their local government (i.e., city or county agency with jurisdiction over the school).
Federal Requirements:	Legislation specifies that the Federal share of this program activity shall be 100%, up to the approved amount. No funding match is permitted.
Project Eligibility:	<p>Funds can be used for the planning, education, and promotion of Safe Routes to School activities and a variety of programs including, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Student Safety Patrol • Pedestrian Education Campaigns • Walk to School Day Events • Bike to School Day Events • Walking School Bus or Bike Train Programs • Bicycle Safety Skills Events • Traffic Safety Events
