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







# Project Development Process



# Design Features

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- Project length approximately 4 miles
- Two 12' travel lanes in each direction with a 12' continuous turning lane, 10' paved shoulders/bike lanes, curb and gutter, and 5' sidewalks on each side.
- Extensive use of retaining walls to minimize impacts to properties
