

LEGAL NOTICE

The Federal Highway Administration has approved the Final Environmental Impact Statement for the construction of Kirby Parkway from Split Oak Drive to Stage Road and Sycamore View Road Extension from Sycamore View Road to Kirby Parkway in Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee.

The approved action calls for the construction of six 12-foot traffic lanes, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, and either a 12-foot continuous turning lane or an 18-foot raised median. The turning lane would be used from Mullins Station Road to Stage Road. The median would be used for the rest of the project. There will be no improvements on the section from Messick Road to Humphreys Boulevard.
