ORDINANCE NO. 2007-04-01

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF MUNFORD, TENNESSEE
MUNICIPAL CODE BY DELETING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 3 AND REPLACING
IT WITH TITLE 4, CHAPTER 3 CODE OF ETHICS.**

Whereas, Public Chapter No. 1 of the Extraordinary Session of the 2006 General Assembly requires the City of Munford to adopt a code of ethics by ordinance and;

Whereas, the Municipal Technical Advisory Service has developed a model Code of Ethics and;

Whereas, the City of Munford wishes to adopt the MTAS model code, and, now therefore:

Be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Munford, Tennessee, that:

Section 1. Applicability. This chapter is the code of ethics for personnel of the City of Munford. It applies to all full-time and part-time elected or appointed officials and employees, whether compensated or not, including those of any separate board, commission, committee, authority, corporation, or other instrumentality appointed or created by the City. The words "municipal" and "municipality" include these separate entities.

Section 2. Definition of Personal Interest. (1) For purposes of Sections 3 and 4, "personal interest" means: (a) Any financial, ownership, or employment interest in the subject of a vote by the City Board not otherwise regulated by state statutes on conflicts of interests; or (b) Any financial, ownership, or employment interest in a matter to be regulated or supervised; or (c) any such financial, ownership, or employment interest of the official's or employee's spouse, parent(s), stepparent(s), grandparent(s), sibling(s), child(ren), or stepchild(ren).

(2) The words "employment interest" include a situation in which an official or employee or a designated family member is negotiating possible employment with a person or organization that is the subject of the vote or that is to be regulated or supervised.

(3) In any situation in which a personal interest is also a conflict of interest under state law, the provisions of the state law take precedence over the provisions of this chapter.

State statutes dictate many of the ethics provisions that apply to city officials and employees.

Campaign finance- T.C.A. Title 2, Chapter 10. Conflict of interest- T.C.A. 654-107 and 8-50-501. Consulting Fee 2-10-122, 124. Crimes involving public officials-T.C.A. 39-16-101, 39-16-401. Ouster law- 8-47-101.


Section 12. Date of Effect. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the city requiring it.
