
2020 Tennessee Drug Overdose Deaths Annual Report


Key Findings:

- In 2020, 3,032 Tennesseans died of a drug overdose. This represents a 45% increase from 2019.
- For the second year in a row, overdose deaths involving Black Tennesseans increased dramatically.
- In 2020, fentanyl was present in two out of three overdose deaths in Tennessee.



Fatal drug overdose increased 45% from 2019 to 2020 in Tennessee.







In 2020, 79% of fatal overdoses in TN involved an opioid.

Commonly found opioids include fentanyl, pain relievers, and heroin.

Fatal overdoses increased in nearly every drug category from 2019 - 2020.
