Your February 7, 2020, request to expand the Virtual Dementia Tour, Comprehensive Experiential Education program to 200 Tennessee certified nursing homes over a three (3) year period has been approved. Originally, Second Wind Dreams was to provide dementia education and training to 100 nursing homes over two years. This change allows Virtual Dementia Tours, education and training to be provide to a total of 200 nursing homes over three years.

Based on our review, we find that the requirements at 42 CFR § 488.433 are met and that the request to expand the project to a third year may be funded with federally imposed CMP funds.
