
Teen Motor Vehicle Accidents


Anderson County, Tennessee

What happened with teens in Anderson County from 2011 to 2015?











Anderson County ranked 64th out of 95 counties for teen crashes and ranked 46th lowest for crash-related ED visits based on 5-year average rates

Teen crash-related emergency department statistics in Anderson County†







More teen females were seen in the ED for crash-related injuries
