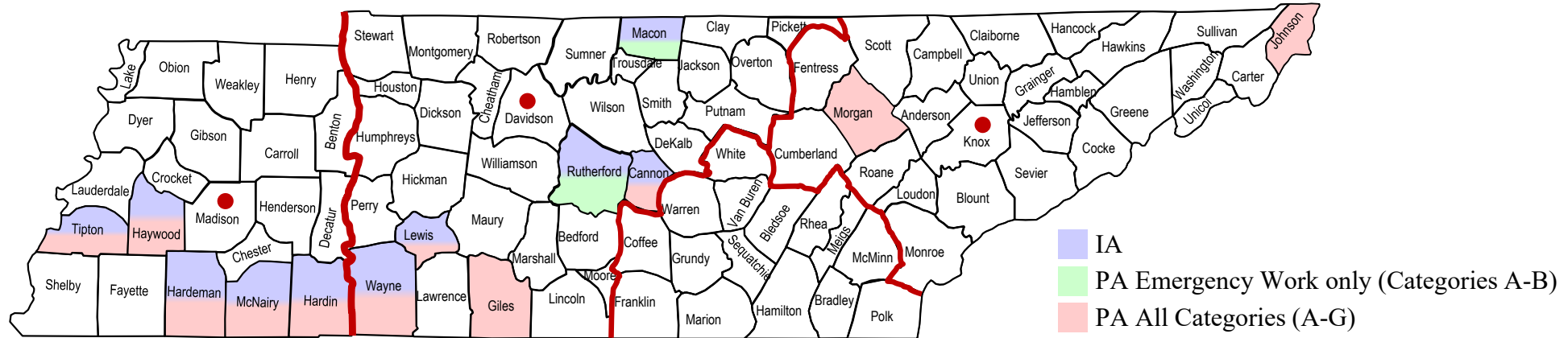

## Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds, and Tornadoes

### TEMA Mission 47



Emergency Work (Debris Removal and Emergency Protective Measures) was awarded under this declaration on April 7, 2023. Counties included were Cannon, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Lewis, Macon, McNairy, Rutherford, Tipton, and Wayne. These counties were also granted Individual Assistance.

On May 17, 2023, the declaration was amended to add the following: Public Assistance (all categories) for Giles, Johnson, and Morgan counties; and Public Assistance Permanent Work (Categories C-G) for Cannon, Hardeman, Hardin, Haywood, Lewis, McNairy, Tipton, and Wayne counties. No additional counties were added for Individual Assistance.

FEMA requires applicants to submit a Request for Public Assistance (RPA) within 30 days of the date of declaration. When more than one date is encountered such as this disaster, there are multiple deadlines for the RPAs. Here's what this means:

For the counties included in the original declaration:

- RPAs submitted between April 7, 2023, and May 6, 2023, are eligible for Public Assistance Emergency Work, Categories A and B. If the county was amended in the May 17, 2023, announcement to include Permanent Work (Categories C-G), then the RPA submitted before May 6, 2023, is sufficient for all categories.
- If the county was amended to include Permanent Work but no RPA was submitted for the Emergency Work before May 6, 2023, the applicant will only be eligible for Permanent Work if they submit their RPA before COB June 16, 2023.

For Giles, Johnson, and Morgan counties, all categories are eligible with the RPA submission before COB June 16, 2023.
