Summary

Tennessee's August seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased to 3.4% from July's rate of 3.3%

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted rate unemployment rate decreased from 4.0% to 3.4% while the U.S. rate decreased from 5.2% to 3.7%.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 114,500 jobs. The largest increases were in leisure and hospitality, trade, transportation & utilities, and education and health services.

Total nonfarm employment increased 3,100 jobs from July to August. The largest increases were in financial activities, manufacturing, and education and health services.






