Summary

Tennessee's February seasonally adjusted unemployment rate increased slightly to 3.4% from the January revised rate of 3.3%.

Over the past year, Tennessee's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained the same at 3.4% while the national rate declined from 3.8% to 3.5%.

Total nonfarm employment increased 4,800 jobs from January to February. The largest increases occurred in health care/social services, transportation/warehousing/utilities, and professional/scientific/technical services.

Over the year, nonfarm employment increased 51,000 jobs. The largest increases occurred in trade/transportation/utilities. leisure/hospitality, and education/health services.








Unemployment Rates - US & Tennessee Seasonally Adjusted - January 2013 to February 2020
